Why did I do this?

- One FAQ is: what is the format for the abstract and how do I submit it?

Logging into WCMT, the Web Conference Management System

I assume you have a web browser open to the web address of the Ottawa conference, <http://www.iemss.org/iemss2010>, but if you are at the main web pages, <http://www.iemss.org>, you get there quickly by clicking on **iEMSs 2010** in the **Meetings** rectangle, third from the top on the left.

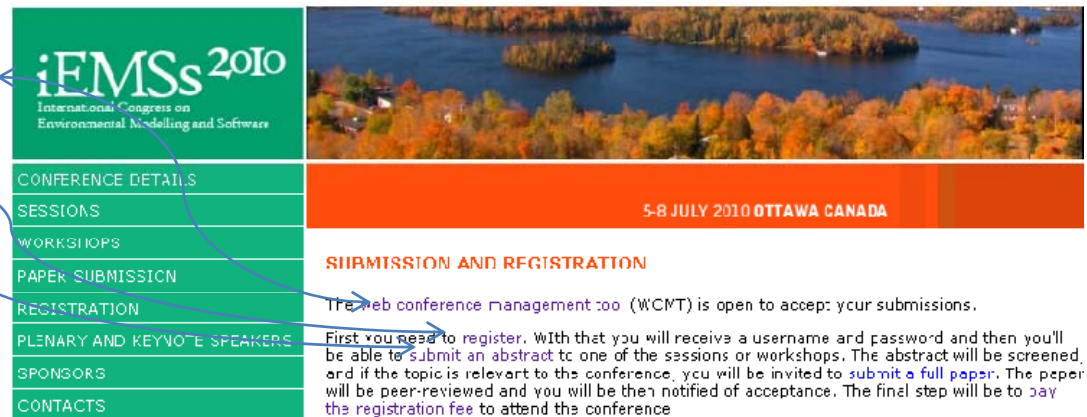

Submitting a paper

Simply click on **PAPER SUBMISSION (1)**, and then click the pop-out **SUBMISSION AND REGISTRATION 2).**

In the new screen is a set of instructions on what to do to become a participant. There are five “click-ons”, but the first three are all we need right now:

1. web conference management tool
2. register
3. submit an abstract
4. submit a full paper
5. pay the registration fee

Getting into WCMT

Clicking on any of these three items puts you into WCMT, whose address is actually

<http://www.iemss.org/wcmt/wcmt10>.

You have to register first, and there are two ways to do it

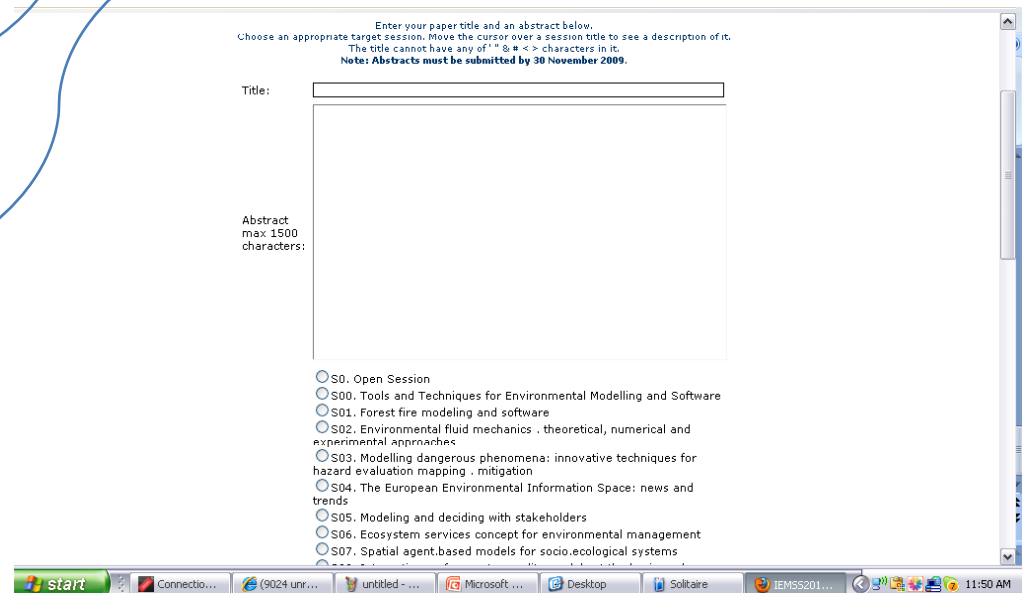
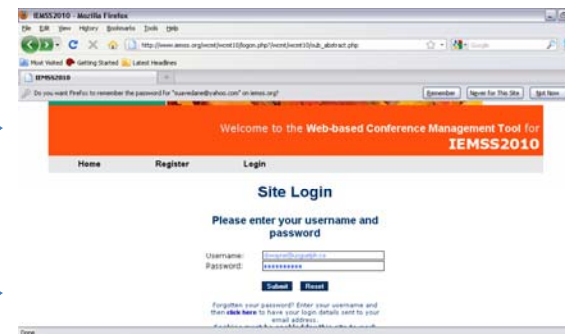
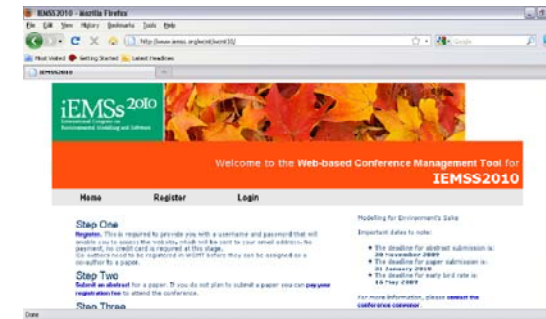
Click on the words web conference management tool and proceed to follow instructions, step-by-step. (the preferred path)

or (2) click on register in the paragraph on the screen to get this.

THEN (same screen)click on submit an abstract.

However you get to this point, and after you lvisit the login screen, your objective is the bottom screen at right

Follow the instructions – use a title with no forbidden punctuation as noted above the title box. This can change for your final submission, in pdf format.

1500 characters is a hard limit. “Sell” your paper within this box. Final submission of an accepted paper or workshop abstract does not have these sorts of restrictions.

Select a session or workshop to which your proposed paper, in your opinion, applies.

You (or we) may have ideas for changes later. The conference abstract acceptance process is a distributed one. Then submit!
